Civic Leadership Engagement Roadmap

In June, The Policy Circle launched a pilot of a proprietary, experiential leadership program called the **Civic Leadership Engagement Roadmap (CLER)**. This innovative, actionoriented curriculum takes our members from having general civic knowledge to becoming civic leaders. A diverse class of 12 changemakers will graduate from the program in December. CLER will launch nationally in 2021.


