MAKING GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABLE



THE U.S. POLITICAL SYSTEM WAS ORIGINALLY FOUNDED ON THE IDEA OF CONSENT OF THE GOVERNED. TODAY'S **GOVERNMENT RELIES ON** THOUSANDS OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICIALS AND ANYWHERE FROM 170 TO 270 EXECUTIVE AGENCIES MAKING AND APPLYING LAWS. THIS OPAQUE POLICY-MAKING **ENVIRONMENT MAKES IT** DIFFICULT FOR CITIZENS TO KNOW WHO IS MAKING DECISIONS.

THE SIZE AND COMPLEXITY OF THE MODERN ADMINISTRATIVE STATE CAN OVERWHELM INFORMED VOTERS TRYING TO FUND OUT WHETHER THE OFFICIALS THEY VOTED FOR ARE KEEPING THE PROMISES, WHAT LAWS ARE BEING MADE AND/OR REPEALED. AND HOW MONEY IS BEING SPENT. ONLY WITH TRANSPARENCY AT THE ADMINISTRATIVE LEVEL CAN CITIZENS KNOW THE DECISION MAKERS AND THE DECISION MAKING PROCESS, WHICH ALLOWS THEM TO HOLD ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE RESULTS OF THOSE DECISIONS.

FACTS TO KNOW

THE 1967 FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA) GIVES
THE PUBLIC THE RIGHT TO ACCESS GOVERNMENT
RECORDS THAT, EVEN THOUGH NOT CLASSIFIED, ARE
NOT OTHERWISE AVAILABLE. ALL FIFTY STATES AND
THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA HAVE THEIR OWN
VERSIONS OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT (FOIA)
LEGISLATION, WITH STATE LEVEL OFFICIALS
RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS,
SPENDING, AND DECISIONMAKING MORE TRANSPARENT.

THE GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY OFFICE IS ONE OF THE KEY SOURCES OF DATA ABOUT IMPROPER PAYMENTS. IN 2018, THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION MADE \$8 BILLION IN IMPROPER PAYMENTS, MAINLY DUE TO OUTDATED TECHNOLOGY. THE FOUNDATION FOR GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY ESTIMATED THAT THE GOVERNMENT MADE AROUND \$300 IN IMPROPER UNEMPLOYMENT PAYMENTS DURING THE PANDEMIC.

OF 39 FEDERAL AGENCIES THAT WERE CONTACTED IN A FOIA REQUEST ABOUT THE PRESERVATION OF DIGITAL RECORDS LIKE EMAILS AND INSTANT MESSAGES, 26 AGENCIES RESPONDED. THE RESPONSES REVEAL ONLY 3 AGENCIES HAVE POLICIES TO AUTOMATICALLY CAPUTURE AND PRESERVE MESSAGES, AND 7 AGENCIES HAVE EMPLOYEES PRESERVE MESSAGES AT THEIR DISCRETION.

SINCE 1996, THE GOVERNMENT HAS NEVER MADE ITS GOAL OF SPENDING 3% OF CONTRACTS ON BUSINESSES IN ECONOMICALLY DEPRESSED AREAS, AND HAS ONLY HIT THE GOAL OF 5% OF CONTRACTS GOING TO WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES IN 2013 AND 2019. ACCORDING TO GOLDMAN SACHS, THERE IS A 15% GAP BETWEEN MEN AND WOMEN BUSINESS OWNERS WHO RECEIVED FEDERAL GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS, AND A 13% GAP BETWEEN THOSE WHO RECEIVED STATE GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS.

GOVERNMENT INVOLVEMENT

THE GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY
OFFICE (GAO), KNOWN AS THE
"CONGRESSIONAL WATCHDOG," IS AN
INDEPENDENT AGENCY THAT EXAMINES
HOW TAXPAYER DOLLARS ARE SPENT. THE
GAO TRACKS FEDERAL SPENDING,
WHETHER PROGRAMS ARE MEETING GOALS,
AND IDENTIFIES FRAUD, WASTE, ABUSE,
AND MISMANAGEMENT OF FEDERAL FUNDS.

THE INSPECTOR GENERAL ACT OF 1978
CREATED THE COUNCIL OF INSPECTORS
GENERAL, AN INDEPENDENT ENTITY
ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.
THEY DETECT AND PREVENT WASTE, FRAUD,
AND ABUSE THERE ARE 75 INSPECTORS
GENERAL RESPONSIBLE FOR OVERSEEING
FEDERAL AGENCIES, AND SIX OTHER ETHICSRELATED OFFICIALS IN FEDERAL AGENCIES LIKE
THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET.





WE OFTEN THINK OF GOVERNMENT AS A
REFEREE THAT SETS AND ENFORCES
REGULATORY RULES, BUT THE GOVERNMENT'S
ROLE A KEY ECONOMIC PLAYER CAN
SUBSTANTIALLY AFFECT THE ECONOMY. FOR
EXAMPLE, THE GOVERNMENT'S VEHICLE
PURCHASES FOR VARIOUS AGENCIES' CAN HAVE
A MAJOR IMPACT ON PRIVATE FUEL EFFICIENCY
STANDARDS, AS WELL AS THE AVAILABILITY OF
HYBRID AND ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

IMPROPER PAYMENTS ARE A SOURCE OF WASTEFUL SPENDING AT THE FEDERAL LEVEL, IN 2019, THE 20 LARGEST FEDERAL AGENCIES REPORTED \$175 BILLION IMPROPER PAYMENTS. MEDICARE, MEDICAID, AND THE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT PROGRAM ACCOUNT FOR \$121 BILLION OF THIS TOTAL.



FRAMING THE ISSUE

CORPORATE WELFARE

THE DETAILS OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENTS
BETWEEN LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND BUSINESSES OFTEN
REMAIN PRIVATE. IN SOME STATES, RECIPIENTS OF ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT DOLLARS ARE GIVEN A SAY IN WHAT DETAILS
ARE RELEASED TO THE PUBLIC; IN OTHERS, EXISTING
STATUTES FAVOR PRIVACY. EVEN PUBLIC RECORDS LAWS
HAVE PROVISIONS THAT PROTECT TRADE SECRETS. SOME
ARGUE THIS IS NECESSARY FOR COMPETITION IN THE PRIVATE
SECTOR; OTHERS AREGUE PUBLIC DISCLOSURE IS A NECESSITY
BECAUSE THE SUBSIDIES ARE FUNDED BY TAXPAYER MONEY.

FAVORITISM

ONE REVIEW OF THOUSANDS OF GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS FOUND MORE THAN 150 COMPANIES RECEIVED CONTRACTS WORTH MORE THAN \$1 MILLION WITHOUT GOING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS. SOME ARGUE THIS IS BECAUSE THE GOVERNMENT SOMETIMES NEEDS TO WORK QUICKLY; OTHERS SAY IT AMOUNTS TO FAVORITISM AND DISCOURAGES OTHER BUSINESSES. ACCORDING TO GOLDMAN SACHS, ABOUT ONE-THIRD OF MINORITY- AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESSES DO NOT SUBMIT BIDS FOR CONTRACTS BECAUSE THEY BELIEVE THE PROCESS TO BE UNFAIR.

YEAR-END WASTE

"USE IT OR LOSE IT" BUDGETING SITUATIONS
INCENTIVIZE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES TO RAMP UP
SPENDING AND USE ANY LEFTOVER MONEY TOWARDS
THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR. AGENCIES KNOW THAT
IF THEY LEAVE SIGNIFICANT BALANCES IN THEIR
ACCOUNTS AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR,
CONGRESS MAY REDUCE THEIR BUDGET IN THE FUTURE.
THIS CAN AFFECT EFFORTS TO REDUCE THE FEDERAL
DEBT BY CONTROLLING SPENDING.

LEGISLATIVE EARMARKS

EARMARKS ARE FUNDS PROVIDED BY CONGRESS THAT APPLY TO A VERY LIMITED NUMBER OF RECIPIENTS AND WERE USED AS A NEGOTIATING TOOL AMONG LEGISLATORS. THEY BECAME SYNONYMOUS WITH CORRUPTIONS AND WERE BANNED IN 2011, BUT REINTRODUCED IN 2021. SUPPORTERS SAY EARMARKS ALLOW LEGISLATORS TO TARGET FUNDS AND CAN PREVENT GRIDLOCK BY SERVING AS A NEGOTIATING INCENTIVE. CRITICS ARGUE EARMARKS CIRCUMVENT THE COMPETITIVE ALLOCATION PROCESS AND THAT CONGRESS'S PURPOSE IS NOT TO FUND LOCAL WISH LISTS WITH NATIONAL TAXPAYER MONEY.



PUBLISH GOVERNMENT RECORDS IN A SEARCHABLE, ONLINE FORMAT

THE INTERNET IS A POWERFUL TOOL TO MAKE GOVERNMENT SPENDING AND RECORDS **EASILY ACCESSIBLE AND** SEARCHABLE TO AMERICANS. GOVERNMENT AGENCIES COULD ENSURE SPENDING RECORDS ARE EASY TO FIND ON AGENCY WEBSITES, AND INDEXED BY MAJOR SEARCH ENGINES.

STREAMLINE THE FEDERAL CONTRACTING PROCESS FOR SMALL BUSINESS

A GOLDMAN SACHS SURVEY OF SMALL BUSINESS OWNES FOUND THAT HALF OF WOMEN OWNERS WHO DIDN'T APPLY FOR FEDERAL CONTRACTS FELT THAT THE PROCESS WAS TOO TIME CONSUMING, AND 40% SAID IT WAS TOO COMPLICATED. A FASTER, SIMPLER APPLICATION PROCESS THAT IS EASY TO **NAVIGATE WOULD MAKE** FEDERAL CONTRACTING MORE **COMPETITIVE AND** ACCESSIBLE TO SMALL, WOMEN-WOMEN OWNED, AND MINORITY OWNED BUSINESSES.

REQUIRE GREATER TRANSPARENCY

AT THE FEDERAL LEVEL,
TRANSPARENCY IN
EARMARKING CAN INCLUDE
REQUIREMENTS THAT
COULD PREVENT ABUSE
AND ENSURE THAT
EARMARKING IS MAKING A
DIFFERENCE IN DISTRICTS.

AT THE LOCAL LEVEL,
BUSINESS-FRIENDLY
POLICIES CAN BE
SUFFICIENT TO CREATE
JOBS AND ECONOMIC
GROWTH WITHOUT
CONFIDENTIAL
AGREEMENTS BETWEEN
GOVERNMENTS AND
SPECIFIC COMPANIES.

STATE. FOSTER COLLABORATIVE
RELATIONSHIPS WITH COMMUNITY
ORGANIZATIONS, SCHOOL BOARDS, AND
LOCAL BUSINESSES.

PLAN -

SET MILESTONES BASED
ON YOUR STATE'S
LEGISLATIVE
CALENDAR OR LOCAL
COMMUNITY CALENDAR.

EXECUTE -

INVESTIGATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE SALARIES AND PENSIONS IN YOUR STATE OR MUNICIPALITY.

DETERMINE HOW YOUR STATE RANKS IN TERMS OF SALARY PAYMENTS AND OVERALL SPENDING.

SEE IF THERE ARE LOCAL WATCHDOG GROUPS IN YOUR STATE OR MUNICIPALITY, SUCH AS EDGAR COUNTY WATCHDOGS.
